Policy on the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

- 1. It is our policy that we recognise that knowledge and skills can be acquired from a wide range of learning experiences, both formal and informal. We therefore encourage the recognition of prior learning (i.e. learning that has been assessed and for which credit has been awarded, often by other providers inside or outside of the UK) and experiential learning (i.e. learning that has taken place in the workplace as a means of providing entry to, or credit within, all of its taught programmes at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. Such recognition will take place within the context of the Progual Framework.
- 2. Recognition of prior learning (RPL) is a process through which previously assessed and learning is considered and recognised towards a defined unit or course. Credit can be used from a previously uncompleted or completed coursed.
- 3. Recognition of prior experiential learning is the process of recognising, learning which has, as its source, some experience which occurred prior to the point of a candidate entering her/his current programme and has been undertaken within a workplace. Experiential learning is defined in this context as knowledge and skills gained through work experiences as well as through non-formal learning, development and training activities.

4.Recognition of experiential learning: It is College policy that responsibility for the award of any credit for experiential learning always falls within the remit of the Assessment
